





The Importance of Safety Data Sheets



- Safety data sheets are the main tool for ensuring that manufacturers and importers communicate enough information along the supply chain to allow safe use of their substances and mixtures.
- Safety data sheets include information about the properties of the substance, its hazards and instructions for handling, disposal and transport and also first-aid, fire-fighting and exposure control measures.

- All Safety Data sheets must carry 16 points of information:
 - 1. Substance ID
 - 2. Hazard ID
 - 3. Composition/Information on ingredients
 - 4. First Aid measures
 - 5. Fire fighting measures
 - 6. Accidental release measures
 - 7. Handling & Storage
 - 8. Exposure controls/Personal Protection
 - 9. Physical & Chemcial properties
 - 10. Stability & Reactivity
 - 11. Toxicological information
 - 12. Ecological information
 - 13. Disposal Considerations
 - 14. Transport information
 - 15. Regulatory information
 - 16. Other information
